### **CSWD Issues New Comprehensive Guide**

When it comes to recycling, composting, community programs, and trash disposal, the 2008 comprehensive guide put out by the Chittenden Solid Waste District (CSWD) is the encyclopedia for Chittenden County businesses and residents. It will be arriving in mailboxes around the 26th of February.

"We usually get a ton of calls on our hotline after the guide comes out," commented Nancy Plunkett, CSWD's Waste Reduction Manager. "They see it and remember all the materials they have hanging around that they want to get rid of. We hope they use this guide to learn how they can recycle and even find reuse for some of those items."

More than 73,500 of the 20-page guides will be mailed to businesses and residents throughout the county. The last guide was printed in May of 2006.

"People really hang onto these guides," said Clare Innes, CSWD's Marketing & Communications Coordinator. "We still have people calling us with questions and learn they're referring to information from a guide from several editions ago. We upped it to 20 pages this year and we still could have filled several more. The website, [www.cswd.net](http://www.cswd.net), holds even more information, and is always the best place to turn to for the most up-to-date information."

In addition, CSWD publishes a monthly e-newsletter that offers information on free round-ups, community events, and tips on recycling, composting, and other ways of diverting as much trash as possible from the trash.
