



Drop-Off Center Fee Increase

Effective July 1, 2007

Dear Valued Customer,

Please take note that fees for household trash and construction and demolition debris will increase July 1, 2007. After more than ten years of continuous service operating at the same rates (for example, \$1.50, \$2.75, and \$4.25 for household trash), we now need to adjust our fees in order to better cover our operating expenses.

The fee increase was approved by the CSWD Board of Commissioners this past spring. Several factors were considered in the decision-making process, including the rising costs associated with employee health care coverage, increasing and sometimes unpredictable fuel costs, the steadily rising costs associated with disposing of trash, and the effects of yearly economic inflation.

We appreciate your patronage and hope that you continue to use the CSWD Drop-Off Centers for your trash and recycling needs.
